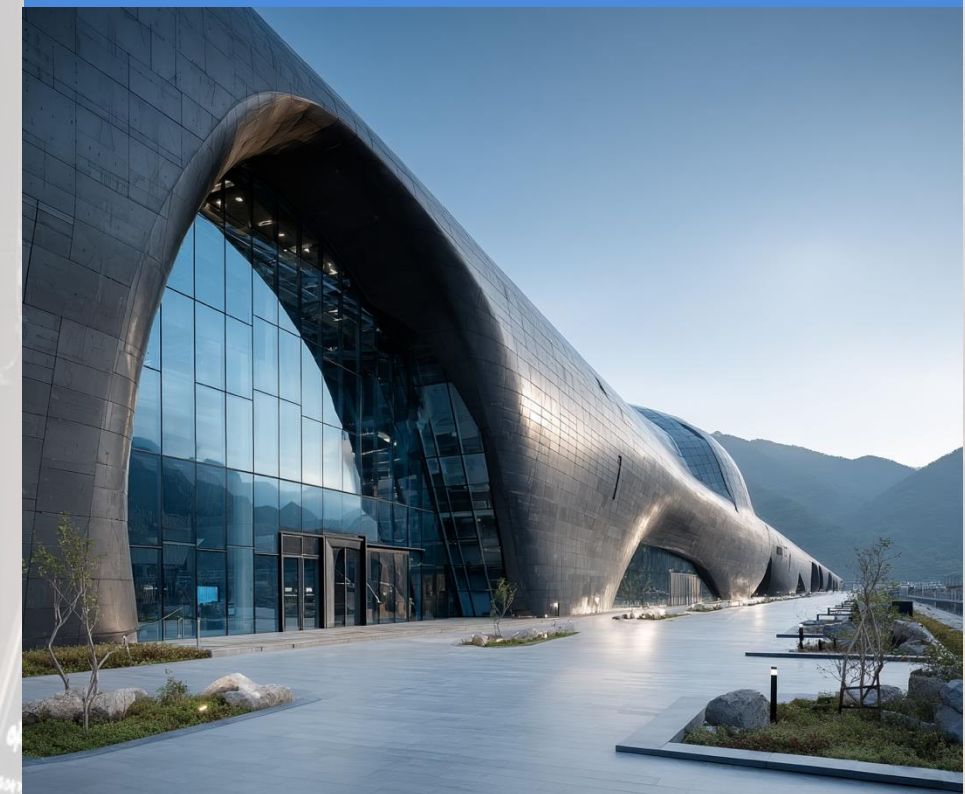
Learn the secrets of earthquake-resistant design by assembling structures using traditional interlocking methods.

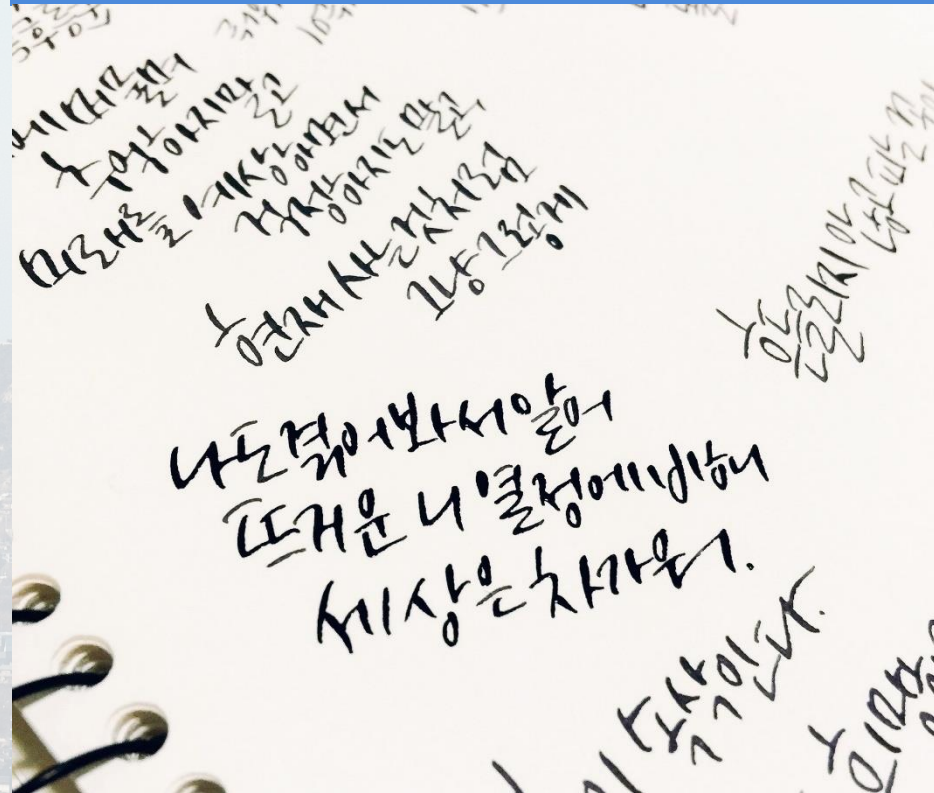
Introspective Activity

Create a card to introduce yourself and beautifully write down your dreams and motto by learning Hangul calligraphy.

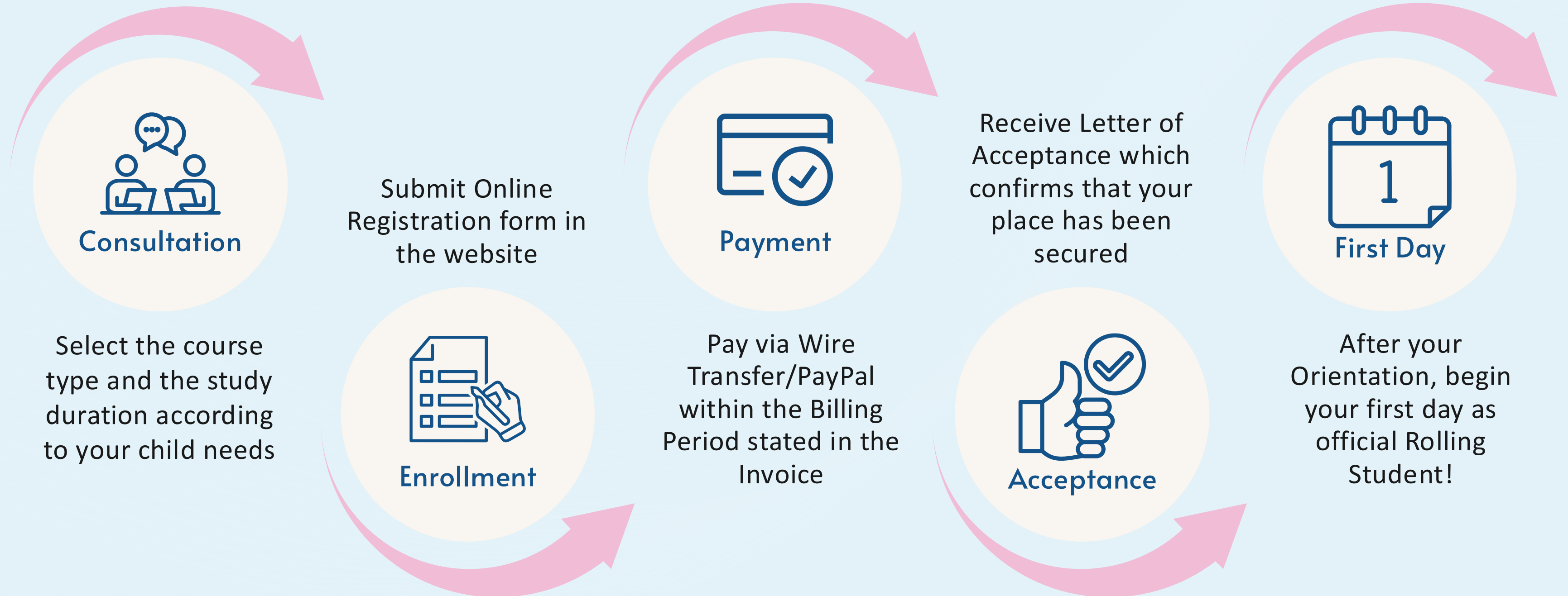
Traditional Fairy Tale
